



ARE YOU UNINSURED AND CAN'T AFFORD YOUR MEDICATIONS?



Ozanam Charitable Pharmacy can help!

Ozanam Charitable Pharmacy is a free prescription drug program for uninsured individuals. Ozanam Pharmacy is located at 571 Dauphin Street in downtown Mobile next to the Catholic Service Center. The pharmacy is opened Monday thru Thursday from 9am to 2:30pm.

How can you qualify?

You qualify if:

- ✦ You reside in Mobile, Baldwin or Escambia Counties.
- ✦ For example, you would qualify if you reside in a three person household making \$25,000 per year.
- ✦ You can show proof of your entire household income.
- ✦ You do not receive government assistance such as Medicaid, Medicare Part D, or Veteran 's Benefits.
- ✦ You do not have prescription drug coverage.

How can you enroll?

STEP ONE: Call (251) 432-4111 to find a Certifying Agency near you or visit our web site at www.ozanampharmacy.org. Make an appointment to see a case manager to qualify.

STEP TWO: Be prepared to bring a Driver 's License or Photo ID, a current bill with address, price list, printout or receipts for medications and household income (everyone living under your roof information) to include all that apply:

- Statement showing social security, disability, retirement benefits, or food stamp letter.
- Pay check stubs or tax return (1099s or W-2s are also accepted.)
- Any other document the patient thinks may be relevant to their financial situation.

STEP THREE – If you qualify, bring a valid prescription to Ozanam Pharmacy to be filled. You will need to be certified every six months. Ozanam does not fill controlled substances.
