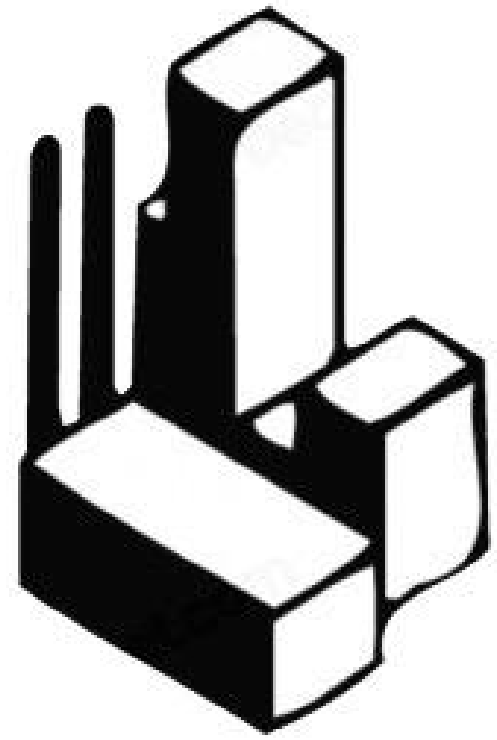

Dispensary of Hope Medication List Definitions

-  **Dispensary of Hope Formulary List** – consistently available generic medication which can be ordered in unlimited supply and replenished weekly as needed
-  **Dispensary of Hope Non-Formulary List** – medication that is irregularly donated and may not be consistently available to order
-  **Dispensary of Hope Samples**– medication donated from provider offices that are typically brand name but may include OTCs
-  **Dispensary of Hope Short Dated List**– medication that has 120 days until expiration – report sent to our network on a monthly basis

Manufacturers have agreed to donate surplus medication to the Dispensary of Hope for redistribution

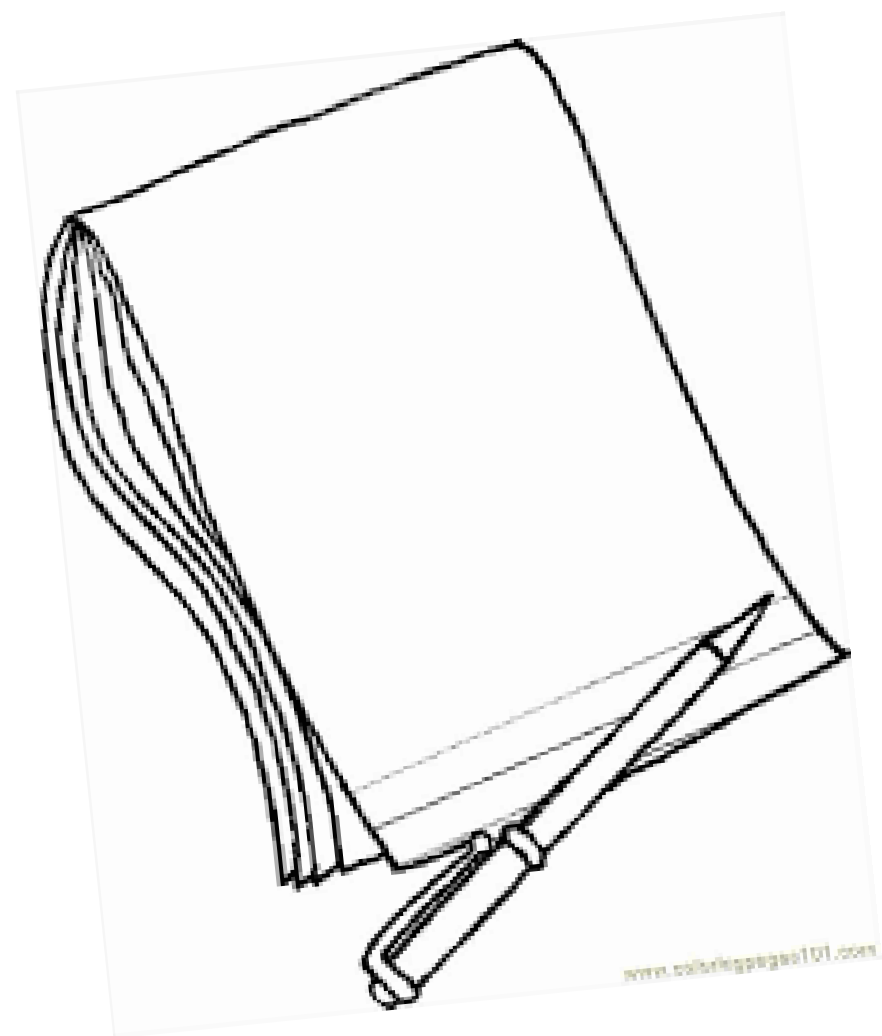


Brands

Over 700 physicians participate in the Hope Box Program by donating unused prescription samples to the Dispensary of Hope for redistribution to the underserved

Dispensary of Hope Medication

- A medication list is developed by the Dispensary of Hope Pharmacist team and used by the Dispensary of Hope Sourcing team to request drugs from manufacturers or physician practices
- The Dispensary of Hope Pharmacist team reviews and updates the medication list **QUARTERLY**



Medication List Principles

- 1) Primary care focus: Most commonly used medication that helps to manage primary care related medical conditions (chronic and acute) is reviewed for inclusion
- 2) Safety & Efficacy: Medication within each therapeutic class is chosen based on clinical evidence and national guidelines, as well as medication safety profiles
- 3) Access: Availability of medication to the market and/or availability of medication to the Dispensary of Hope depends on current manufacturer partners
- 4) Evidence of need: Historical data based upon ordering habits in eHope and medication requests from Dispensary of Hope access sites are reviewed to assess need
- 5) Exclusions to the Medication List: Oral contraceptives, controlled substances

Medication Availability

- Supply is strictly donation based. The benevolence of drug manufacturers and other donors determines what drugs are made available to the Dispensary of Hope
- Manufacturer partners – The Dispensary of Hope is currently partnered with 16 generic manufacturers. As we continue to add more partners, more medication will be available
- Backorders – Medication may be unavailable due to manufacturer backorder. The Dispensary of Hope alerts our sites of these backorders and our pharmacist offers possible alternatives, if available, that the on-site provider can review/approve

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Ordering Medication Tips

- Begin with small orders and a lean inventory
- Identify drugs currently dispensed to uninsured patients

Tips on How to Use the Dispensary of Hope Formulary

- Share the formulary with your providers (each quarter)
- Therapeutic Substitutions - when drugs aren't available, using an alternative may be necessary. Search by drug classification in eHope to see alternatives available within that class
- Collaborative Practice Agreements - if a provider prescribes a medication that is not on the formulary, it can be substituted for a formulary medication with the same therapeutic outcome

Tips on using eHope

- Try to fill your patients' needs with formulary options on the eHope website
 - (**) & **green highlight** indicate Non-Formulary medication that is not regularly received by the Dispensary of Hope.
- If your medication is not in stock, consult with prescribers (when applicable) about alternative medication within a drug class
 - The IAP Available Inventory Report can be viewed in eHope to determine medication in stock at the moment you are ordering. This report can be exported to Excel or generated as a PDF.
